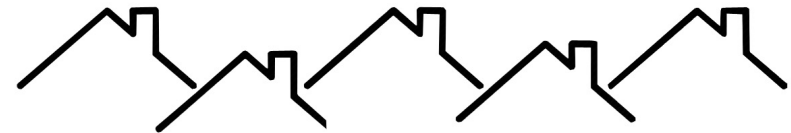

New Town Retail Precinct Streetscape upgrade: Project Update

The City of Hobart's project team has been undertaking community consultation to understand the community's issues and aspirations relating to the New Town Road shopping strip. Information has been collected about how the precinct is currently accessed, what people currently value about the place and how it could be made more accessible and attractive in the future.

A survey was open for four weeks and about 120 people had their say. Officers also held workshops with groups of students from Sacred Heart College, New Town Primary School and New Town High. In addition, a community workshop was held at Sacred Heart College on the evening of Thursday 24 August.

Next steps: The City's project team is now working closely with a group of New Town community members

who have volunteered to participate in four collaborative planning workshops. This Project Action Team (PAT) includes local residents, New Town Community Association representatives and local business operators.

The PAT will consider a range of information including the results of the wider community consultation. They will work through priorities and options, and make recommendations on behalf of the community, for the Council's consideration. This process will finish in November. The City's officers will then develop some plans which will be shared with the wider community for feedback in 2018.

The purpose of the collaborative PAT process is to ensure that local community stakeholders are deeply involved in the discussions and decisions that will affect their local shopping precinct. The City of Hobart appreciates the time and contribution the PAT members are volunteering on behalf of the New Town community.
